The American Association of Law Libraries (AALL) is excited to provide comments on the report of the U.S. Government Publishing Office (GPO) Task Force on a Digital Federal Depository Library Program (FDLP).

AALL supports the Task Force's recommendation for the FDLP to become a digital program that a digital FDLP has the potential to make government information even more accessible in the future. Our comments address *Section F, Strategic Framework and Implementation*, which provides ideas that will inform the Task Force's work as it finalizes its report. We also agree with the Task Force's conclusion that there is an ongoing need for the GPO to provide access to a limited number of print federal legal materials. Some publications, including the *Congressional Record*, the *U.S. Statutes at Large*, and the *Code of Federal Regulations*, are required by law.
